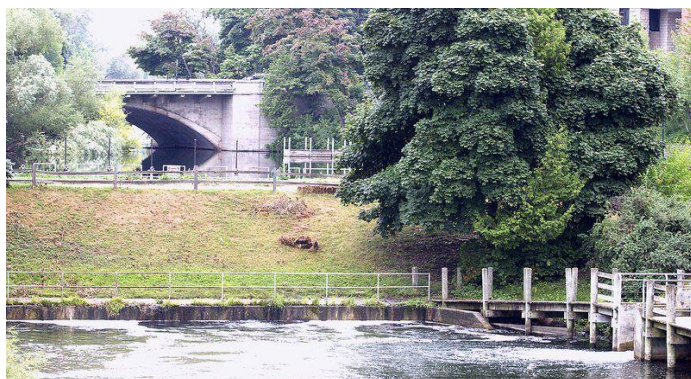

### **Tonight's topic is an up-date report of the FishPass project.**

TRAVERSE CITY — The planned FishPass system for Traverse City's Union Street Dam calls on fishery, biology and engineering disciplines to create the next big thing in fish management.

If FishPass succeeds: "Traverse City can boast of solving a global problem and it will be exporting more than cherries," said Marc Gaden, the bi-national Great Lakes Fishery Commission spokesperson for the project's lead agency.

The multiyear river restoration — "The Boardman River: A River Reborn" — reconnects the Boardman River and its tributaries for free-flow into West Grand Traverse Bay.
